All delegates must register before the introductory address at 8:00 am.

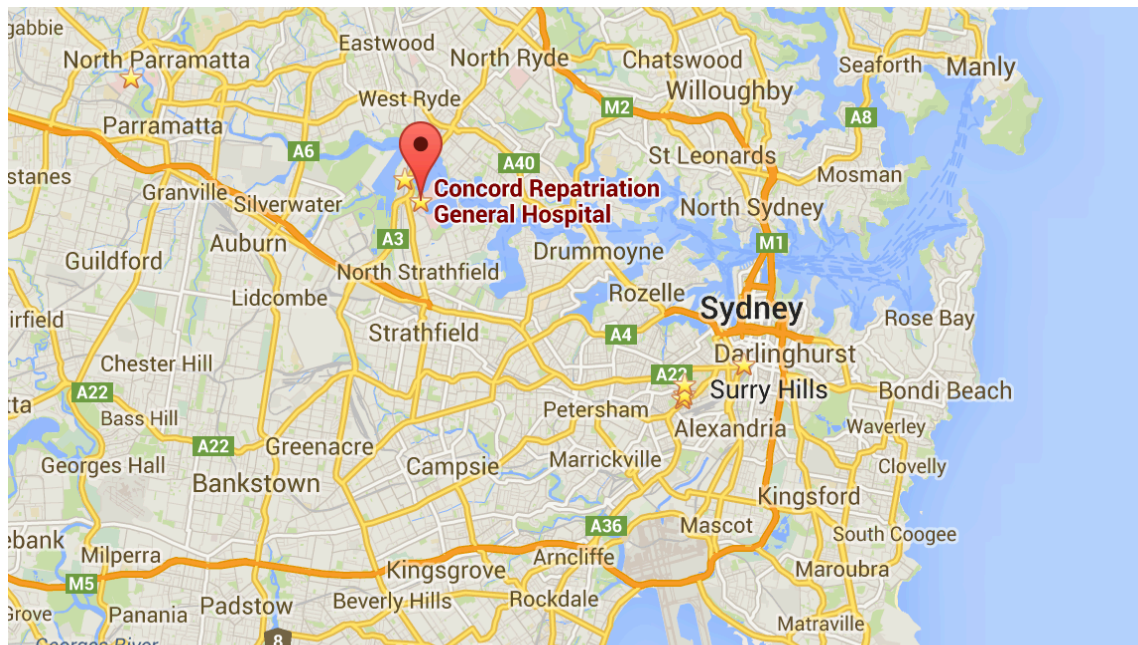
## Dress Code
